

## ***Developing pharmacy leadership programme***

To build on the launch of the NHS Leadership framework and tools, CPPE has designed a programme to support the next generation of leaders within pharmacy. Developed in partnership with London Pharmacy Education and Training and collaborating with the NHS Institute for Innovation and Improvement and National Leadership Council and other pharmacy colleagues and organisations, we have put together a programme which is supported by a range of leadership resources. We used a model for this programme that encompasses the Leadership Competency Framework for Pharmacy Professionals (LCFP).

The full *Developing pharmacy leadership* programme offers pharmacists and pharmacy technicians the opportunity to develop personal leadership skills and behaviours and apply them in their workplace. This programme has three components: an *Inspiring future pharmacy leaders'* event, materials to facilitate five learning community sessions and a follow-up event.

### ***Inspiring future pharmacy leaders' events***

Our events aim to encourage future leaders in pharmacy to explore the challenges and rewards of leadership and inspire them to develop their leadership skills and behaviours. This full-day event will include keynote speakers on inspirational leadership, an introduction to the Leadership Competency Framework for Pharmacy Professionals, real life scenario and leadership activities and an introduction to tools and support for setting up learning communities.

### ***Developing pharmacy leadership series***

- demonstrating personal qualities
- working with others
- managing services
- improving services
- setting direction.
